• OMHA – Rep: U9 MD call for September 18th, if a team had a MD team for U9, they must attend this call, if they didn't their team would be removed from the loop. U9MD Teams are not approved if there are more than 5 U8s on it. - OMHA is wanting them to create a U9 committee, power point for how to run the U9s and following the pathways, so many new rules, etc. need live barn or video footage of all practices, there was supposed to be a pilot for this that never happened. - VSC OPP is 2 months behind with VSC requests. To be able to complete rosters, we may need to use other names of people who are certified in the organization to get them completed for tournaments and stuff, they can always be changed after. Not supposed to approve anyone who was picked in May, if there is an issue - all avenues must be explored before accepted. Fall made teams will be an exception to this. Todd said it only takes them seconds to approve so he isn't going to get made if rosters are submitted 5 to 6 times. Also do not forget to get your bench staff to fill out their Release forms if they have switched centres and their

commitment forms. - Renewal of Operators coming soon, probably within the next couple of weekends, an email will be sent out about this. - Some affiliation changes - kids can affiliate to more than one team in the organization in the same centre. There was a question brought forward if kids can affiliate to different centres because of open borders, Todd didn't think so but said he would pose a question to ask about this. He stated they may be fine with this for goalies because goalies would be a special case but will have to ask. Some of the scenarios being thrown around were: the U18 Frontenac goalie can they be APed to Loyalist, and a Stone Mills HL goalie can they be APed to Napanee. Make sure anyone APed signs the Affiliate Player Form and when writing on it we have to put age group, centre designation and centre name: U13 B Tweed Minor Hockey Association. - There is an OMHA league survey coming out soon that they would like every centre to fill out. If you are unsure of any carry over suspensions get in touch with your centre contact and if they can't look it up and if cannot find then get in touch with Kim with OMHA, her new email is: kim.thurston@OMHA.net - She wanted to reiterate that players who are suspended currently can play exhibition games, these will not serve as served games for their suspension, they can only serve suspensions in league games. - Reminder to use the Exhibition Game Sheet code for all exhibition games, not the regular season code. - For suspensions Kim said she doesn't need notification, she will get notification of them already, then will update the centre contact to update the team. The only time Kim would like us to update her with suspensions is if we are in a tournament and if wherever we are playing uses paper gamesheets, then you need to grab your teams copy and email it to her. - Any select teams need to sign the spreadsheet with Nancy here and for LL meeting she will be there too. U7s and U8s cannot come up to play Select, a question was purposed if a U8 is playing on a U9LL team can they do select, Todd will have to ask about this and get back to us. -U9LL teams have to be majority U9 players, but can move up U8's to them. - Season Start Date of October 3rd and Season End date of Feb 8. - First group of Round Robins to start Feb 9th, these will determine tiers, then play downs begin. - Just a heads up, teams will be playing over March Break so a heads up for anyone planning trips during playoffs. - U18 Question: this is being brought back to each centre and Marilynn to send an email and get each centres preference - Scenario 1: U18 follow the rest of the teams with season end of Feb. 8th and follow OMHA Format - Scenario 2: U18s extend past Feb 8 and finish playing each team in double home and away games as there are only 8 teams, if we do this it is an even amount of games to determine tiers and would go right into playdowns - Currently U18s have 21 games, they would be extended to 28 games if scenario 2 was selected, this means 11 home games or 14 if scenario 2 selected. - U13s will have 24 games, 12 home games - Reminder of League fees due by next meeting, it is \$40.00 a team. - Executive Positions voted on: VP East: Chris from Napanee nominated and accepted, VP West: Matt from Norwood nominated and accepted - Vote was done on moving U13 and below to games of 10-15-15 and no flood, this was brought to table and was unanimously voted a no. Staying as 15-15-15. - Motion came forward to vote if we would like this for U11, vote brought forward and unanimously it was a no as well. - This is probably going to be brought up in the spring again. - Ipad access code, if you have not received email Marilynn. - Scheduling Meeting for Rep: September 27, 2025, Doors open at 9am, 930-1230 - U11/U13 and U18 and 1230-330 - U9/U15 and U21, ice scheduler and someone for each team should be there, bring your calendars and a pencil. -Next Meeting is October 8, 20205 at 7pm in Stirling
